

PRO BONO STATUS FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

How much is the license fee?

The annual license fee is \$200. Starting with the 2021 licensing year, the license fee will be waived for pro bono status members who completed at least 30 hours of pro bono service with one or more QLSP in the prior year.

I want to switch to Pro Bono status but I don't know which QLSP to work with.

Contact the WSBA at publicservice@wsba.org. We will put you in touch with our Public Service Programs Manager, who can connect you with an organization that meets your needs.

Can I volunteer with more than one QLSP?

Yes. If you volunteer with more than one QLSP, complete page 4 of the application with the information about the additional QLSP and deliver it to the WSBA. We will provide you with an additional pro bono card with the name of the QLSP.

What do I do if I switch QLSPs?

You must notify the WSBA and complete page 4 of the application with the information about the new QLSP and deliver it to the WSBA. We will provide you with a new pro bono card with the name of the new QLSP. Do not engage in the practice of law until you receive approval and a new ID card for your new QLSP.

I am no longer practicing with my Pro Bono license. What do I do?

Notify WSBA at <u>statuschanges@wsba.org</u>. We will transfer your license to Inactive status, and you can decide whether to return to Active status or pursue another status option.

How do I get my organization listed as a QLSP?
