APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

- This is the application for admission to the limited practice of law in the State of Washington as a Foreign Law Consultant. Read the application carefully. Answer each question completely. Attach additional sheets as necessary.
- **THE RESPONSIBILITY OF FULL DISCLOSURE RESTS ENTIRELY UPON THE APPLICANT.** No disclosure, or minimal disclosure, may be considered a reflection on the applicant's moral character. Experience has shown that failure to disclose may itself result in denial of admission. Disclosure permits an evaluation of the application upon its merits without injecting failure to disclose as a factor. **THERE CANNOT BE TOO MUCH DISCLOSURE.**
- One original and one copy of this application are to be filed together with certain certificates, letters of recommendation and other items requested in this application. There must be one original of each document.
- The application fee is \$1,220 which must be paid at the time this application is filed.
- Processing may take up to six months.
