Free Alternative Ways to Earn CLE Credits

Members of the Washington State Bar Association can earn credits for free via several methods under the recent update to Admission and Practice Rule 11.

Mentoring – participating in an approved, structured mentoring program.

Legal Writing – for the purpose of legal education and published by a recognized publisher of legal works.

Pro Bono Services – provided through a qualified legal services provider.

Judging a Law School Competition – includes judging and preparing students at a recognized law school competition, including moot courts and mock trials.

Teaching CLEs or Law School Courses – presentations at approved CLE courses or teaching law school courses as a non-full time professor.

Preparing to Teach a CLE or Law School Course – preparation hours can be claimed based on the total presentation time. The rate is five hours of preparation credit can be claimed per hour of presentation.
