

Washington State Bar News Submission Guidelines

Featured Articles

Articles are accepted from WSBA members and nonmembers on topics of interest to WSBA members. Articles should not have been submitted to any other publications. Articles generally run 1,500 to 3,500 words and can be submitted as an attached Word document by email to barnewsarticles@wsba.org. Articles become the property of WSBA and the editor reserves the right to edit articles as deemed appropriate. Citations should be formatted as endnotes. Please include a brief author's bio and contact information at the end of the article. Authors are encouraged to send a high-resolution digital photo of themselves with their submission. Articles can be written in the style or voice that the author wishes. The editor may work with the writer, but no additional proofs of articles will be provided. Generally, six weeks lead time is needed in order for an article to be published in the next issue of *Bar News*, although the editor reserves the right to make the decision when and if to publish an article. You may withdraw your submission at any time by notifying the editor or emailing barnewsarticles@wsba.org. *Bar News* is published on the first day of the month, 12 times a year. The circulation as of January 2012 was approximately 31,000.

News items will be considered if the items are of special concern to Washington state lawyers and will be featured in the FYI section, which appears monthly. Items such as awards given to WSBA members or appointments of WSBA members to boards or organizations will be considered for the "Around the State" column, which appears quarterly.
