

2017 Legislative Session Report

Overview

The Washington State Bar Association (WSBA) participates in the legislative process in a variety of ways. In addition to sponsoring legislation, WSBA monitors legislative proposals introduced by members of the Legislature regarding statewide public policy issues.

After determining if a legislative proposal meets <u>General Rule (GR) 12.1</u>, a WSBA entity may determine further action is needed. In accordance with the <u>WSBA Legislation and Court Rule Comment Policy</u>, WSBA entities may comment publicly regarding a legislative proposal after approval of at least 75 percent of their executive committee and final approval by the Board of Governors (BOG) Legislative Committee. Commenting publicly may include testimony before a legislative committee or submitting written materials to members of the Legislature.

2017 Session Summary

The Washington State Legislature adjourned from its third 30-day special session July 20, 2017. As of the date of this report, the Washington Legislature served three 30-day special sessions and one 105-day regular session.

June 30, Gov. Inslee signed an <u>operating budget</u> that appropriates \$43.7 billion over the 2018-2019 biennium, equating to an increase of \$5.2 billion from 2015-2016 state spending levels. Appropriations include funding for the Administrative Office of the Courts, the Office of Civil Legal Aid, and the Office of Public Defense. Significant funding was allocated to K-12 public education in order to satisfy McCleary ruling requirements. Funding was also allocated to fulfill collective bargaining contracts, and address statewide homelessness and services for mental health.

Legislators also passed a supplemental transportation budget. Legislators did not pass a capital budget during the 2017 session, but they are expected to do so during the 2018 session.

WSBA-Request Legislation

The BOG approved sponsorship of two Bar-request bills in November 2016. Originating from the Corporate Act Revisions Committee of the Business Law Section, <u>Senate Bill 5011</u> modernizes Washington's Business Corporation Act to better reflect current corporate business practices, create process efficiencies, and ultimately attract new corporations to Washington State. This bill made appropriate changes within Washington's Business Corporation Act (RCW 23B. 12, 23B. 07, 23B. 11, 23B.19, 23B. 01, and 23B.02).

Originating from the Real Property, Probate, & Trust Section, <u>Substitute Senate Bill 5012</u> provides a simple, low-cost way for modernizing trust documents while protecting the interests of beneficiaries. Based on the 2015 Uniform Trust Decanting Act, the bill also creates provisions for specialty trusts in situations where the beneficiary has become disabled. This bill made appropriate changes within Title 11 RCW.

SB 5011 and SSB 5012 passed the full Legislature this session and Gov. Inslee signed them into law

Non-WSBA Request Legislation

WSBA Outreach and Legislative Affairs (OLA) staff referred approximately **679** bills to WSBA entities during the 2017 session. The referral of these non-WSBA request bills resulted in various internal stakeholders participating in legislative hearings, meetings, and other efforts to ensure bills either reached final passage or were tabled for further consideration. These efforts were based on analyses conducted by WSBA entities in collaboration with the OLA staff.

After conducting a GR 12.1 analysis, WSBA entities elected to take the following positions for bills referred:

- Support;
- Oppose;
- Neutral; or
- Concerns.

In addition to taking a position on bills referred, WSBA entities also identified a priority:

- High;
- Medium;
- Low; or
- Monitoring.

This information assisted with relevant legislative strategy and subsequent legislative activity throughout session that included collaboration with legislators, staff, and other relevant organizations across the state. <u>Appendix A</u> details bills referred to WSBA entities during the 2017 legislative session. <u>Appendix B</u> details session statistics.

Legislative Interim

Over the remainder of 2017, legislators continued to address the capital budget. Ultimately they did not pass a capital budget and it will be a priority issue during the 2018 session. Legislators studied public policy issues for introduction during the 2018 session. OLA staff and relevant WSBA entities monitored and participated in these discussions with legislators and various stakeholders regarding potential legislative proposals.
