AN ACT Relating to **establishing the court unification task force;**

1

2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

3

4 NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. (1) The legislature finds that:

5 (a) Washingtonians seeking legal help encounter barriers navigating  
6 disparate local court rules or incur increased costs for legal  
7 practitioners to navigate these systems;

8 (b) Specific groups of Washingtonians, such as those living in rural  
9 areas or in poverty, may be inequitably impacted by courts' disparate  
10 adoption of technology to create remote filing, record sharing,  
11 processes, procedures, and hearings;

12 (c) Disparate local rules and adoption of technology make it  
13 difficult for lawyers - including those engaging in pro bono and legal  
14 aid work - to practice in multiple jurisdictions, exacerbating  
15 Washington's "legal deserts;"

16 (d) Washingtonians seeking legal help may encounter inequitable  
17 outcomes due to disparate funding levels and standards from jurisdiction  
18 to jurisdiction;

19

1 (e) City and county leaders have expressed significant and urgent  
2 concerns with their ability to fund and implement the Washington state  
3 bar association's new standards for indigent defense, which derive from  
4 a Constitutional mandate; and

5 (f) Disparate funding between the state's court systems can cause  
6 inequitable and inconsistent means for jurisdictions to implement and  
7 uphold best legal practices and standards.

8 (2) The legislature further finds that potential solutions to these  
9 issues warrant further study, including data collection to better  
10 understand the impact to the public and the legal profession of disparate  
11 local rules, technology, and funding between Washington's court systems.

12 (3) Therefore, the legislature intends to convene and meaningfully  
13 engage stakeholders across Washington state, especially those in rural  
14 areas, and to study the inefficiencies and inequities resulting from  
15 disparate local court rules, funding, and technology.

18 NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. The court unification task force is established  
19 to conduct a comprehensive analysis of the current Washington state  
20 court system, including the review of the structure, policies,  
21 practices, and procedures of the state courts, and identify areas where  
22 a more unified or centralized approach to court operations may improve  
23 efficiency and uniformity in the delivery of court and judicial  
24 services, as well as consistency in outcomes and ease of access for  
25 those who use the court system, including victims, defendants,  
26 litigants, and counsel.

29 NEW SECTION. Sec. 3. (1) The court unification task force is to  
30 include the following voting members:

31 (a) Two legislative members, one from each of the two largest  
32 caucuses of the house of representatives, appointed by the speaker of  
33 the house of representatives. One member shall be the current chair of

34

1 the civil rights and judiciary committee of the house of  
2 representatives.

3 (b) Two legislative members, one from each of the two largest  
4 caucuses of the senate, appointed by the president of the senate. One  
5 member shall be the current chair of the law and justice committee of  
6 the senate.

7 (c) One person representing the governor's office, appointed by the  
8 governor;

9 (d) One person representing the attorney general's office, appointed  
10 by the attorney general;

11 (e) One person representing cities, appointed by the association of  
12 Washington cities;

13 (f) One person who is an elected county councilmember representing  
14 counties, appointed by the Washington state association of counties;

15 (g) One person representing court clerks, appointed by the  
16 Washington state association of county clerks;

17 (h) Twelve members from the judicial branch, appointed by the chief  
18 justice in consultation with the board of judicial administration,  
19 supreme court, court of appeals, superior court judges association,  
20 association of Washington superior court administrators, Washington  
21 association of juvenile court administrators, district and municipal  
22 court judges association, district and municipal court management  
23 association, misdemeanor probation association, and access to justice  
24 board. Two members must be appointed to represent the superior court  
25 judges association, with one member representing western Washington and  
26 the other member representing eastern Washington. Two members must be  
27 appointed to represent the district and municipal court judges  
28 association, with one member representing western Washington and the  
29 other member representing eastern Washington;

30 (i) One person appointed by and representing the tribal state court  
31 consortium;

32 (j) One person appointed by and representing the office of public  
33 defense;

34

1 (k) One person appointed by and representing the office of civil  
2 legal aid;

3 (l) One person appointed by and representing the administrative  
4 office of the courts

5 (1) One person appointed by and representing the Washington state  
6 bar association;

7 (m) One person appointed by and representing the Washington  
8 association of prosecuting attorneys;

9 (n) One person appointed by and representing the Washington state  
10 paralegal association;

11 (o) One person employed by and representing a community-based non-  
12 profit organization that provides advocacy and support services, but  
13 not including legal representation, to court-involved individuals;

14 (p) One person appointed by and representing the Washington  
15 association of sheriffs and police chiefs; and

16 (q) One person appointed by and representing an organization that  
17 represents survivors of gender-based violence.

18 (r) Two people who have lived experience as a litigant in a civil  
19 court matter and who are appointed by the office of civil legal aid.  
20 One person must be from one of the five largest counties. The other  
21 person must be someone who was unrepresented in their civil legal matter.

22 (s) One formerly incarcerated person appointed by the office of  
23 public defense.

24 (2) The task force shall have two co-chairs. One co-chair shall be  
25 the chair of the civil rights and judicial committee of the house of  
26 representatives and the other co-chair shall be the chief justice of  
27 Washington supreme court. ~~The commission shall select the second co-~~  
28 ~~chair by a majority vote of the commission members.~~ The co-chairs shall  
29 set the agenda and provide leadership and direction for the task force.

30 (3) Members of the commission shall be reimbursed for travel  
31 expenses. Legislative members of the task force shall be reimbursed for  
32 travel expenses in accordance with RCW 44.04.120. Reimbursement for  
33 nonlegislative members is subject to chapter 43.03 RCW. To ensure that  
34 the task force has diverse and inclusive representation of those

1 affected by its work, task force members, including work group members,  
2 whose participation in the task force may be hampered by financial  
3 hardship and may be compensated as provided in RCW 43.03.220.

6 NEW SECTION. Sec. 4. The court unification task force has the  
7 powers described in this section.

8 (1) (a) The task force may form issue-specific subcommittees to focus  
9 on issues relevant to the work of the task force, including, but not  
10 limited to: information technology in courts; court capacity and  
11 funding; small and rural courts; facilities and personnel, court  
12 provided services, and the impact of legislative changes on court  
13 resources and processes.

14 (b) The task force shall define the scope of activity and subject  
15 matter focus required of each subcommittee.

16 (c) A subcommittee may set its own agenda and terminate upon  
17 completion of the subcommittee's work. Subcommittee meetings may occur  
18 in person or in a virtual or hybrid format.

19 (2) The voting membership of each subcommittee is composed of a  
20 subset of members appointed to the task force, as determined by the  
21 majority vote of the task force. A subcommittee may invite persons with  
22 relevant expertise to participate in the subcommittee's work as  
23 nonvoting members on an ongoing, recurring, or one-time basis.

24 (3) Consistent with funds appropriated specifically for this  
25 purpose, the commission may hire staff or contract for professional  
26 assistance.

27  
28

29 NEW SECTION. Sec. 5. (1) The court unification task force shall  
30 hold its first meeting by October 1, 2025, and shall complete its work  
31 by December 31, 2028. The task force shall hold no fewer than two  
32 meetings of the full membership of the task force in a calendar year.

33  
34

1 (2) By June 30, 2026, the task force shall submit a preliminary  
2 report to the interbranch advisory committee established in chapter 2.76  
3 and the relevant committees of the legislature.

4 (3) By June 30, 2027, the task force shall submit its final report  
5 to the interbranch advisory committee established in chapter 2.76 RCW  
6 and the relevant committees of the legislature. The final report must  
7 propose specific solutions for the efficient use of resources, including  
8 harmonizing any conflicting court policies, practices, and procedures,  
9 and include a long-term strategic plan to implement the proposed  
10 solutions.

11 (4) After the task force submits its final report and before June  
12 30, 2028, the task force shall hold at least one meeting of the full  
13 membership of the task force.

16 NEW SECTION. Sec. 6. This chapter expires December 31, 2028.

19 NEW SECTION. Sec. 7. Sections 2 through 6 of this act constitute a  
20 new chapter in Title 2 RCW.
