



Using Audience Polls in Your Presentation

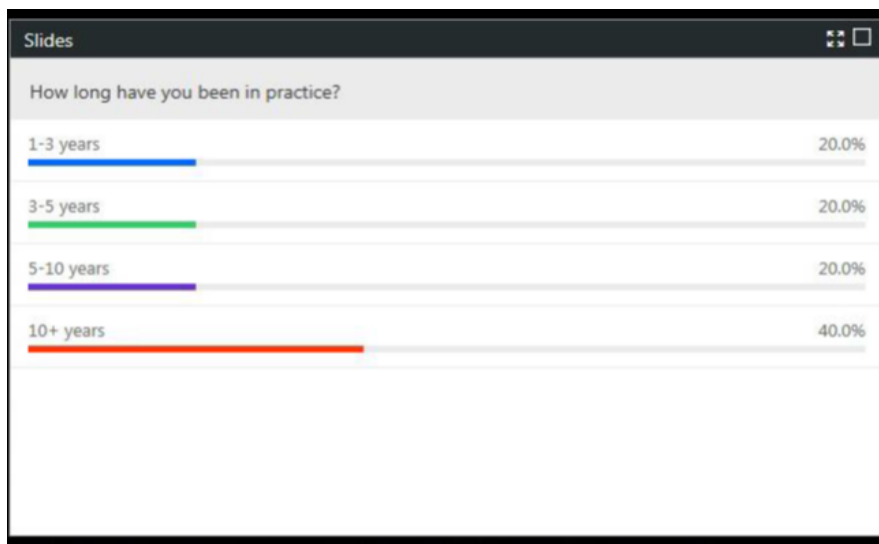
Polls can be great way to engage your audience! If you would like to use a poll in your presentation, please include the question and all potential answers on the PowerPoint slide where you would like the poll to appear (or email us this information if you are not using a PowerPoint), and WSBA staff will build the poll in On24 so attendees can answer in real time.

Presentation tip: Please plan to leave each poll question on screen for at least 30-45 seconds so attendees have time to answer, and pause to allow for responses. You will be able to see the percentage of attendees who have answered who have responded before revealing the results.
