

FY 2026 Limited Practice Board Committees

LPO Examination Committee: Identify, with Court approval, subjects to be covered on the LPO examination; develop, write and maintain questions and practical problems for the LPO examination; grade essay and problem sections of the examination. Chair Kim Chose.

Discipline Committee: Serve as discipline committee under Rules for Enforcement of LPO Conduct (ELPOC) which requires reviewing grievances and making decisions on whether to investigate and/or dismiss. Monitor and make recommendations regarding disciplinary rules. Chair Tom Peterson.

Forms Review Committee: Review proposed forms for use by LPOs, develop forms for use by LPOs when necessary, and make recommendations to the Board for the approval of forms for use by LPOs. Chair *(vacant pending Court appointment to Board)*.

Liaison Committee: Establish and maintain communication with entities both inside and outside the WSBA, including the Supreme Court, the Board of Governors and the Department of Financial Institutions (DFI). Chair Nate Scott.

Rules Committee: Reviews rules related to the LPO license, drafts amendments or new rules when necessary and makes recommendations to the Board for the approval of rules. Chair Tom Peterson.
