Board Business:

• Board discussed the option of creating LPO education requirements. The Board discussed the reasons for the educational requirements including potential improved exam pass rate and better prepared LPOs. The Board also discussed how the educational requirement seems like a regulation being placed on employers and that most employers hire employees based on experience, not necessarily educational certificates/degrees. The Board discussed the low passing rate and exam format. WSBA staff stressed the exam cannot be adjusted by the Board. The Board and WSBA staff discussed the option of a community college offering a certificate degree to people who are interested in an educational component to prepare for the LPO exam.

The Board concluded that an educational requirement is not necessary at this time and voted unanimously to not create any educational requirements for the LPOs.

- Next LP Board meeting is August 14.
- LPO exam will be held July 23 and test results will be released roughly six weeks later.
