- 1. <u>December 15, 2015 Meeting Minutes</u>: The December 2015 Meeting Minutes were unanimously approved.
- 2. Theme of the Retreat: The Future of WSBA Sections

Greg: We've been one of the leaders in the opposition to the Sections' Workgroup's Proposals.

### 3. The Future of of our Section:

History of the Sections Workgroup is recapped Major proposals: (1) changing to a one-size fits all Charter system (2) pooling Section funds (3) Section leadership term limits; structured officers

Workgroup has identified problems, which were never quantified by the BOG Importance of maintaining non-attorney membership on EC Greg recaps his conversation with Anthony Gipe Sections don't recognize that they are a financial drain on the Bar 28 ways of doing things - staff say this is an administrative nightmare

Bruce and Jennifer summarize the 1-19-2016 Sections Workgroup meeting Bruce recaps history of per-member fee - "should be" covering the cost of our Section

Valid goals of Workgroup: fiscal responsibility, efficiencies in administration, what can we agree on? Start with that

## 4. General Discussion on Response(s) to Workgroup Proposals:

Proposal: Pooled Section reserves

Bruce: we need correct and accurate financial accounting

It looks like per-member charges are covering overhead, help us understand

Nancy: We need an ad-hoc Section Workgroup

Karin: What are staff doing to support Sections, can we decide what we need?

Collective agreement: Because we don't really know what the problem is, it's difficult to come up with alternative proposals.

Nancy: suggest there be a template for Section Bylaws; subject to unique needs, e.g. Criminal Law need for representation of both defense and prosecution

Bruce: A uniform elections template; uniform fiscal year; bar licensing & section dues the same all increase efficiencies. We can agree with these Workgroup suggestions.

The Elephant in the Room: WSBA management is responsible for the "fiscal cliff", not the Sections. The Referendum was 4 years ago. Why has spending continued???

Sections are not independent entities. WSBA validly wants Sections to follow WSBA directives

Sections don't get financial credit for subsequent CLE sales - this doesn't change Section administration shortfalls

Formal GR4 request? We can piggyback on other Sections who are more knowledgeable Suggestions on how to address fiscal cliff

Letter to Section Chairs - we'll cooperate, support, add our name to their requests for information

Consensus: Ad Hoc Committee to craft letter which reflects those proposals SSP Section does not object to: Nancy, Shashi, Mark, Bruce - ad hoc committee crafting non-objection letter to be ready by February 4 meeting, feedback from EC accepted through February 5

Proposal on Uniform Leadership: Sections must be able to have their own leadership

Referendum: waiting for BOG action (if any)
