

Volunteer Opportunity: Disciplinary Advisory Round Table

The Disciplinary Advisory Round Table (DART) acts as a forum for the discussion of issues affecting the discipline system for licensed legal professionals in Washington state. DART provides an annual report to the Washington Supreme Court and the WSBA Board of Governors, including any recommendations for change and the identification of concerns or issues.

DART members meet on an ad hoc basis to review, discuss, and provide comment on issues that concern the discipline system. Appointment is for a three-year term beginning in October and is eligible for reappointment to one additional term.

Term:

- One Year
- Two Years

Time commitment: DART hold two-hour meetings on an ad hoc basis.

Requirements:

- 1 Lawyer – Respondents Counsel
- 1 Public Member (a member of the public or community)
- 1 Limited License Legal Technician
- 1 Limited Practice Officer

Meetings:

- In-Person Only
- Virtual Only
- Hybrid

Preferred qualifications and skills: Some knowledge of court or administrative-adjudicative processes and procedural rules would be helpful.

Benefits: Members will learn about the lawyer disciplinary system and process and the development of disciplinary systems for other licensed legal professionals in Washington state.
